Budget and Referendum Update

On April 11th, the Annual Town Meeting will be held and I anticipate April 24th will be set as the date of the Town of Stafford Budget Referendum. A 'yes' vote will mean that the town mill rate will increase by 1.83, bringing the total mill rate to 38.59 mills, or a 4.97% increase from this year. This translates to an increase of \$248.19 yearly (\$20.68 monthly) for the median home value (\$135,000). The BOE budget increase is 2.75%, of which only 0.5% is not due to contractual or mandated increases. If the Budget Referendum does not pass, there is a strong likelihood that any resulting reduction will result in cuts to services or programs at the schools. Your vote matters!

Board of Education Policy Update

At the April 1st Board of Education meeting, Policy 4111/4211 Hiring of Staff was revised to delineate the hiring of certified versus non-certified staff and details the responsibilities of the Board of Education and the Superintendent of Schools. Policy 4120/4220 Nepotism is a new policy and provides guidelines on the hiring of family members of Board members and the Superintendent of Schools. Policy 4111.1/4211.1 Affirmative Action: Recruitment and Selection was found to be redundant with existing policies and was repealed.
