Attendance Areas

A student shall attend such school as is designated by the Superintendent in accordance with attendance areas approved by the Board. When teacher-student load is high and additional classrooms are not available in a given attendance area, the Superintendent has authority to transfer students from one attendance area to another.

The following are among the criteria taken into consideration in making the determination relative to the transfer of students:

- a. The geographical proximity of the student's home in relation to the school to which he or she may be transferred
- b. Whether or not the student being considered for transfer has siblings in the school from which he or she may be transferred.
- c. Specialized educational programs in accordance with the student's needs.
